**CaseWorks Student Fellow Description**

Columbia CaseWorks Student Fellows will work with Columbia CaseWorks staff on developing cases and supporting the CaseWorks program during the academic year beginning in the fall after the spring selection process. The CaseWorks Student Fellows both act as ambassadors for the CaseWorks program and are involved in the case development process, including initial brainstorming on case topics, faculty meetings, and editing of final cases. Each Fellow's role will be defined by his/her interests and skills both in the support of the program and in the development of the cases themselves. The average time commitment, while flexible, is three hours per week (12 hours/month).

The attached description outline the program as currently envisioned. The Fellows selected for September 2014 to May 2015 will help define the role as they go through the year.

We are looking for students who have excellent oral and written communication skills. Experience producing written work will be weighted heavily. Fellows must have a strong academic record.
